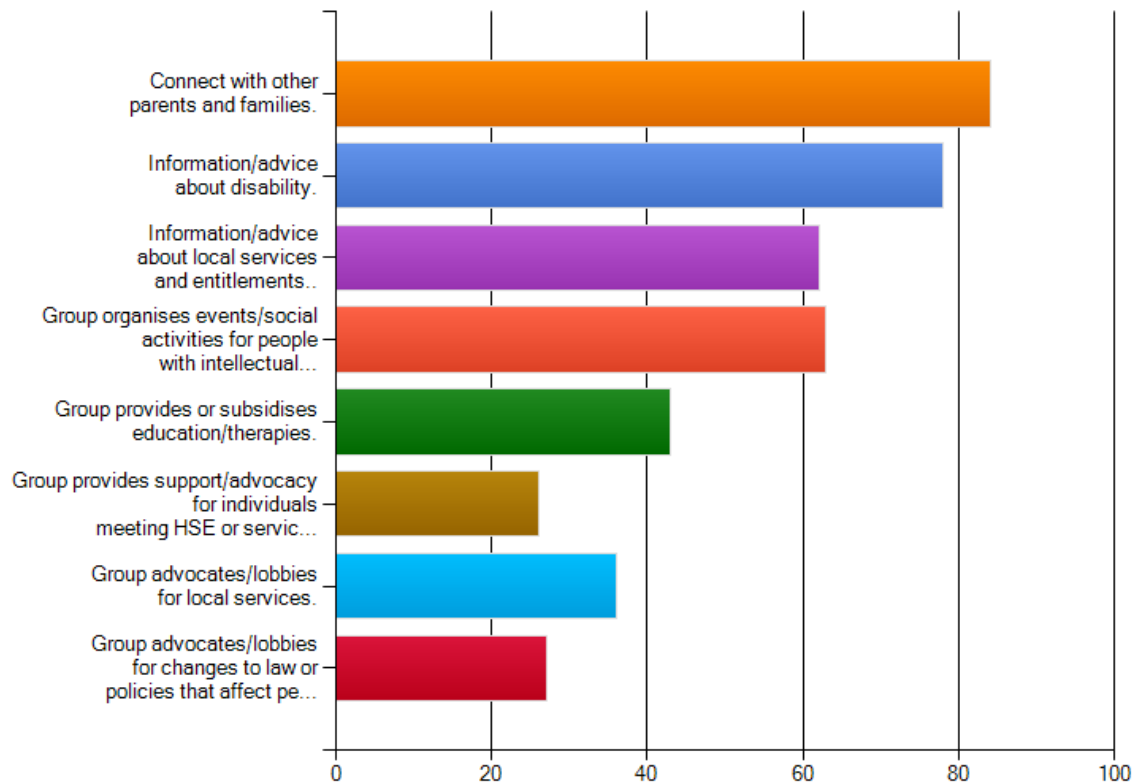

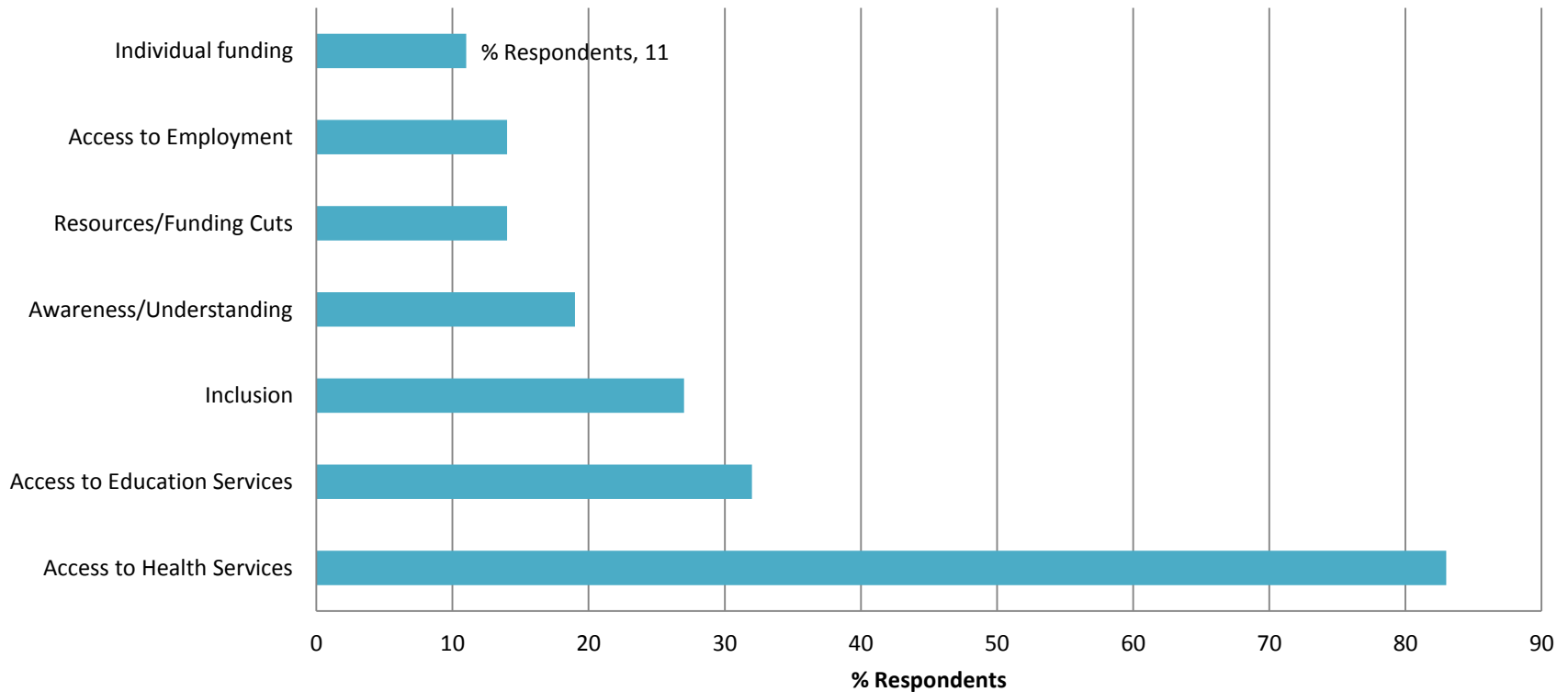

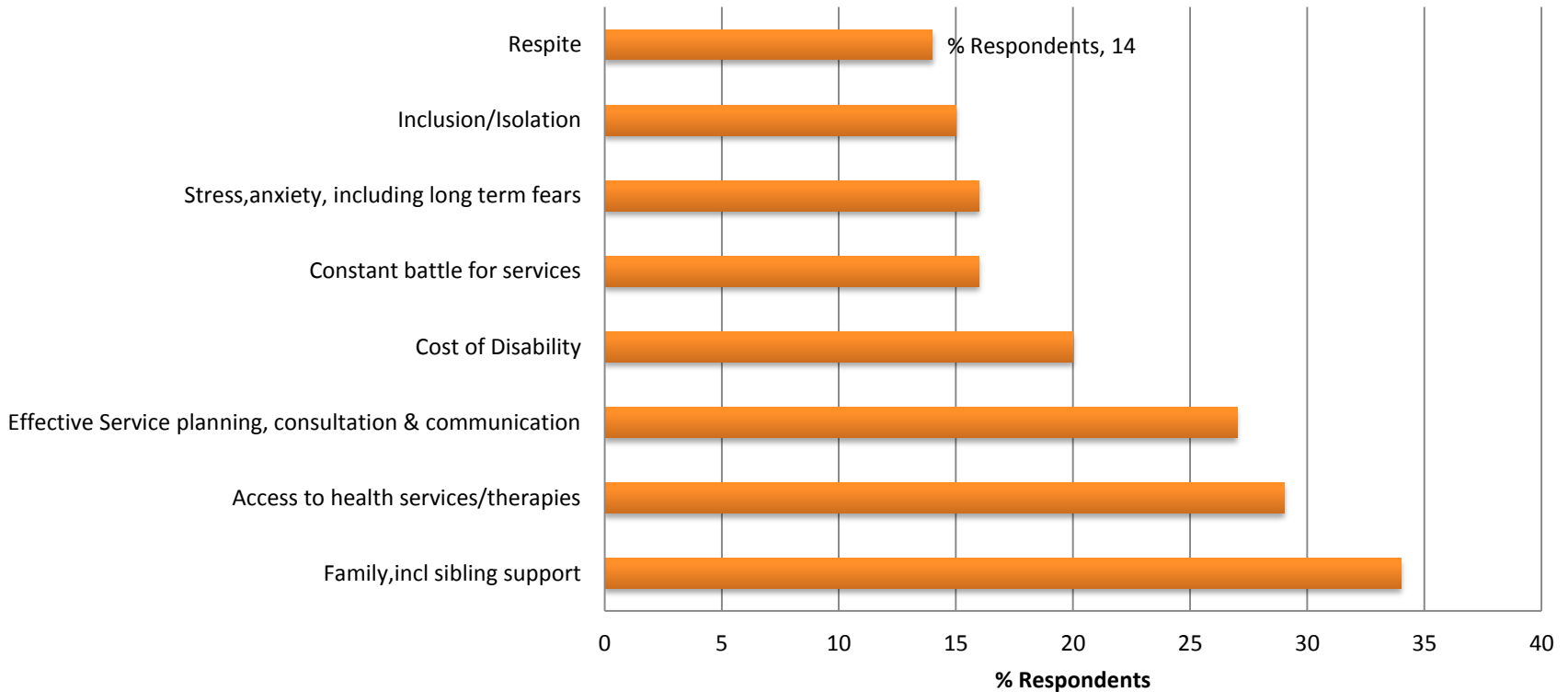


What in your opinion are the key issues for persons with intellectual disability in Ireland in 2015

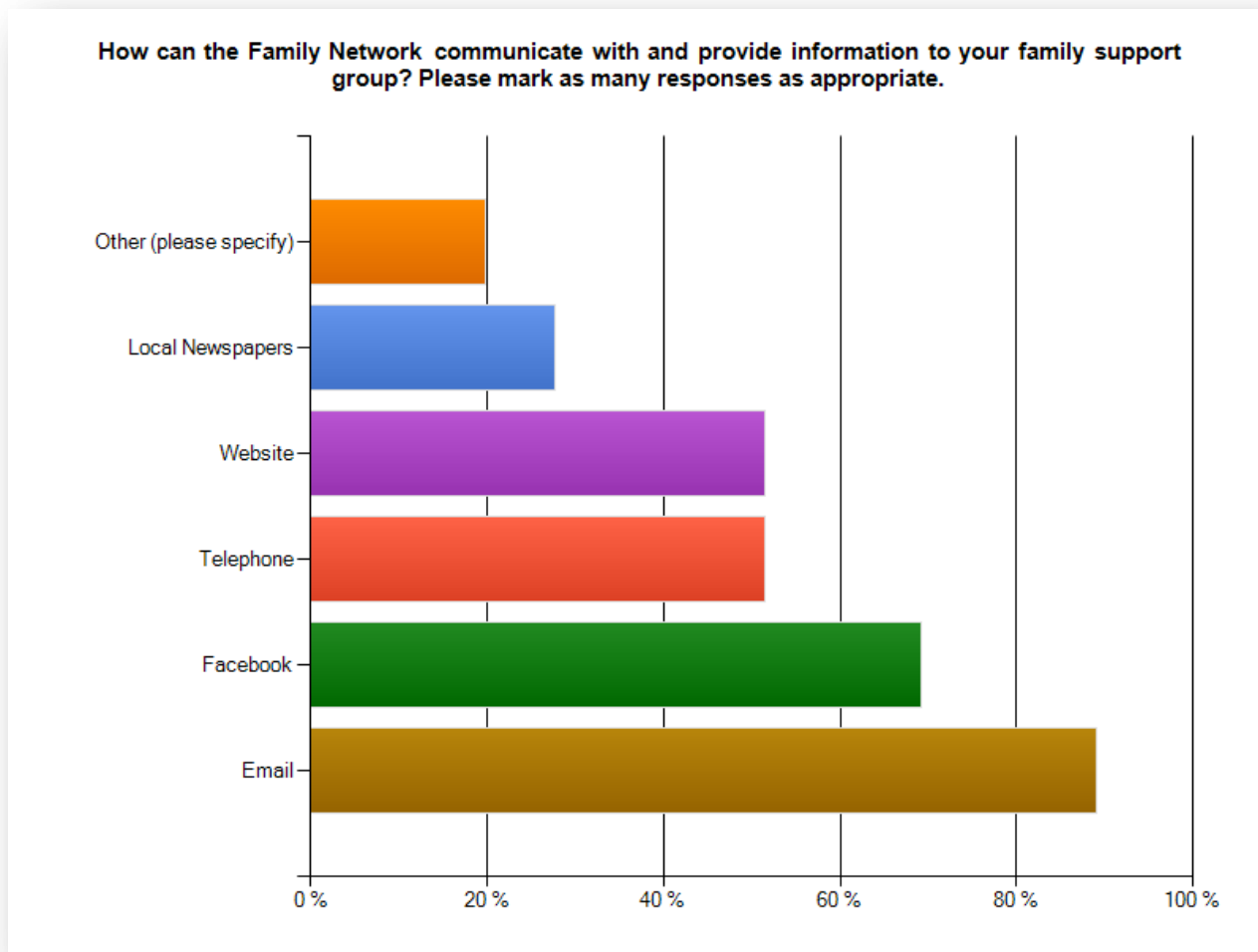


Key Issues for Families page 15 chart

What in your opinion are the key issues for families of persons with disability in Ireland in 2015?

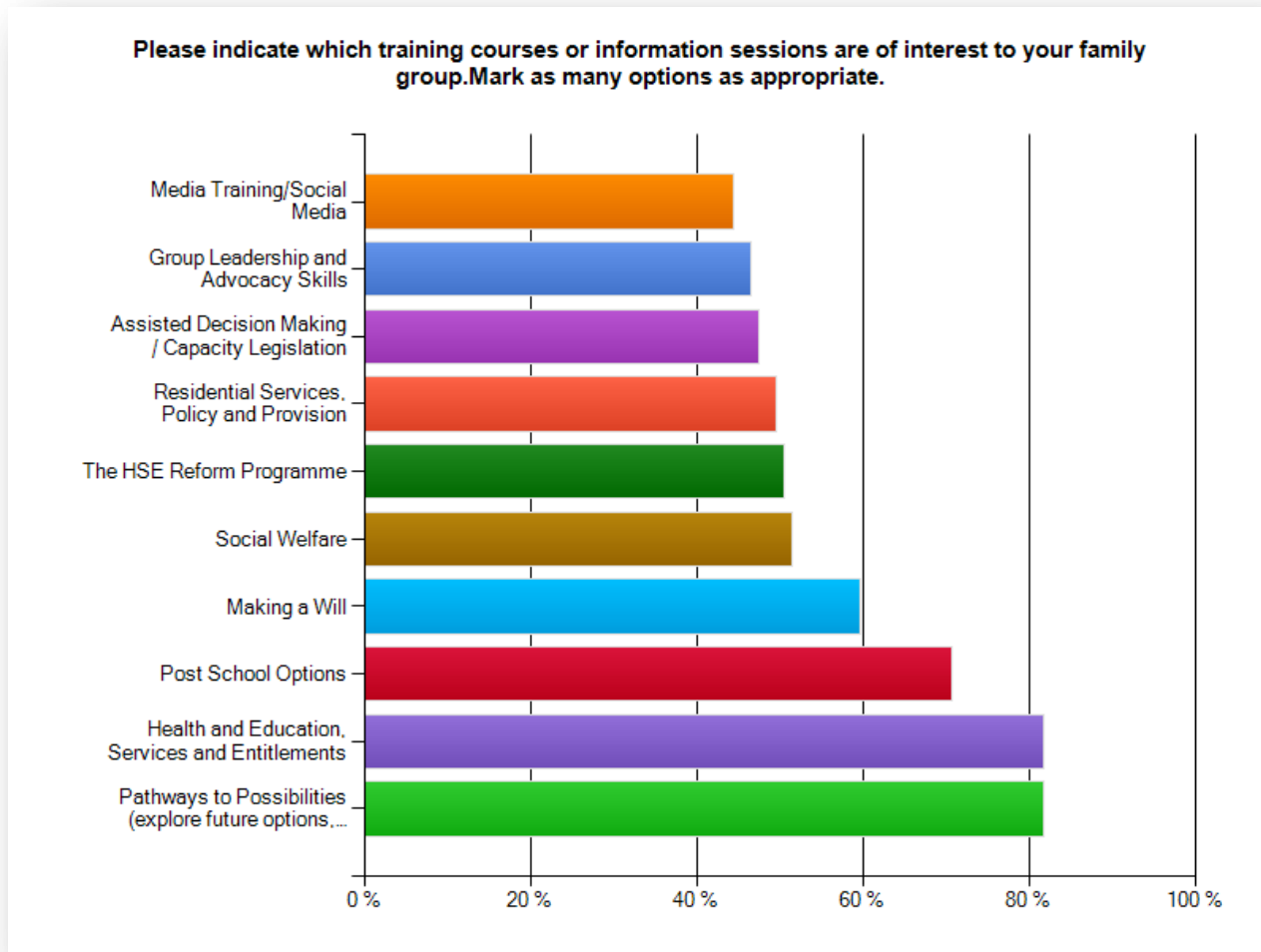

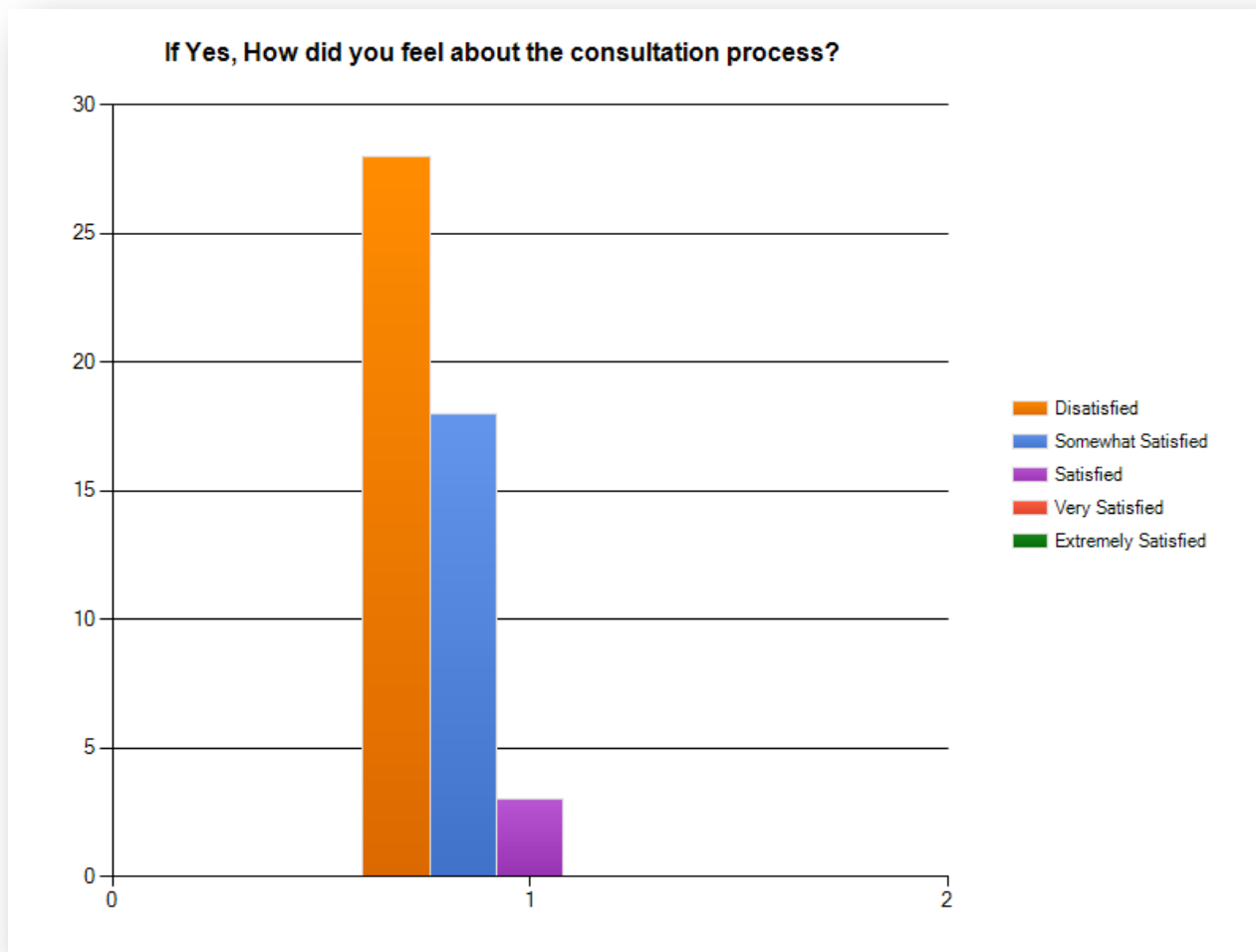
