What is the protest about?

We are calling on Ireland to ratify the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD)

Why are we protesting?

The UNCRPD is an agreement on the rights of people with disabilities.

Ireland signed the UNCRPD 10 years ago but has not ratified it (brought it into Irish law)

The gates of Leinster House, Kildare Street

When

March 30th 2017 between 11am – 2pm
