Interview with Paul Alford, Inclusion Ireland Self-Advocacy Project Worker



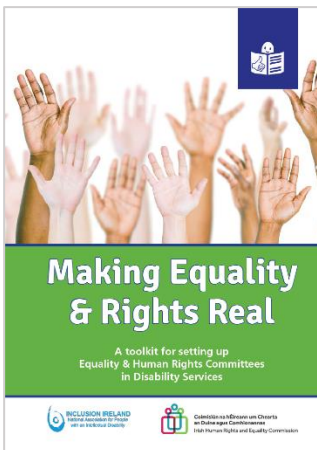
Paul Alford is a self-advocacy project worker for Inclusion Ireland.



In an interview, Paul told us about two Inclusion Ireland projects that were funded by the Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission.

The first project happened in 2017 and it was about showing people how to set up Equality and Rights Committees in disability services.



The second project has been happening in 2018 and is about checking your local public services to see if they are accessible and if they treat people with disabilities equally.



Paul said that it was important to Inclusion Ireland that the project was as inclusive as possible.



The people that took part in the project got paid for their time in the projects and for doing workshops with a bit of support.



Paul says Inclusion Ireland's Human Rights and Equality Statement says that inclusion is necessary for people to fully take part
